

In a place, where you wouldn't expect a so beautiful scenery, there is a fantastic waterfall. In a small canyon there is this amazing waterfall, but only during the rainy season, unfortunately as many others in Sardinia. Being one of its most important features, it becomes really interesting at the eyes of a landscape photographer, just because you can find it only for short time during the year. It makes a jump long over 30 meters, maybe more because I've never calculated how it is tall. The waterfall finishes in a small lake where you can take some pictures, but it is possible to photograph it even from the top.

Access rating



Depending on what you are interested in, there are two trails for reaching the waterfall. Trail **1** is for taking a picture from the top, trail **2** for the bottom. In both trails I highly recommend you to wear wellingtons in order to cross the stream, otherwise you won't be able to do anything. Be careful because you need to pass through some private property, so where you find some gate, remember you to close them. How to get there

You'll arrive from Santa Maria Coghinas village and it would be better using a satnav (check the map below) until the car park.
